

Acceptable baggage

Making your way to the airport soon?

Make sure you familiarise yourself with the new baggage rules

To reduce delays; acceptable baggage rules have been implemented by ACSA, effective from **25 March 2019**.

The following bags will **NOT** be permitted:

- Round bags
- Bags with long hanging straps or those without flat surfaces

These bags are the largest sources of jams in the baggage handling system, causing shut downs and delays in delivering the bags to the aircraft. As a result, this also causes inconvenience to passengers and airlines.



Regular



ONLY **regular-shaped bags** and bags with **at least one flat surface**, will be allowed at check-in counters.



Irregular



Round bags, **bags without flat surfaces** and bags with **long hanging straps**, will not be allowed.

Note: Irregular-shaped bags can be wrapped at baggage approved wrapping stations at the airport.
